

The High School Graduation Checklist For Parents

6-12 Months Before Graduation:

- Confirm the graduation date and time with your child's high school.
- Check your child's academic record to ensure they have met all graduation requirements.
- Start thinking about graduation party planning and guest list.
- Look into available graduation attire options and place an order.

4-6 Months Before Graduation:

- Order graduation announcements or invitations to send to family and friends.
- Make travel and lodging arrangements for out-of-town guests.

2-4 Months Before Graduation:

- Attend any necessary parent-teacher conferences or meetings with your child's guidance counselor.

1-2 Months Before Graduation:
